Game Day Information Boys Lacrosse 2009

- Game Time:** Start times of 5:00, 5:15, or 5:30 - Varsity to follow
- Locker Room:** Visiting teams will use the locker rooms located on the southeast side of the Panther Dome. A Coach from the visiting team must be present in the locker room at all times.
- Pre-Game Warm-ups:**
- 4:00** – Teams arriving early that would like to warm-up and/or stretch may utilize the eastern (upper) field Weber field or the grass located area between the tennis courts and the Panther Dome. Visiting teams are asked to refrain from throwing lacrosse balls in all OTHS parking lots.
- 4:30** – Lacrosse teams will not be permitted on the stadium field until 4:30. At this time, both the home and visiting teams may utilize the north half of the field (closest to parking lot) for stretching.
- If OTHS Soccer is not present, the entire full field may be used.
 - For safety reason, no balls are to be used if track and/or soccer are still in the facility including on the track- goals, corner flags, team benches, scorer's table, and mats may be placed in position at this time.
- 4:40** – Full Warm ups- full field available for both teams.
- Entrance:** Please enter through the main gate and cross the track using the turf mat.
- Cleats on the track:** Please make every effort to limit the amount of movement on the track with cleats on. Definitely no warm-ups on the track with cleats on!!
- Filming:** Videoring space will be assigned to the visiting team if they choose to film.
- Ticket Prices:** Tickets will be sold 30 minutes before game time.
Adults are \$3; Students with ID are \$2; Under 6 & 60 and older are free.
- Parking:** All buses (Team, Fan, etc) are asked to park in the Weber Parking lot (just east of the school stadium). Buses are permitted to load/unload in the main parking lot.
- Medical Assistance:** The OTHS Athletic Trainer will be present at all home games.
